# Welcome, Approval of Agenda and Minutes

Henry Nelson opened the meeting by welcoming everyone. He asked for a roll call of the Alabama Charter School Commission (APCSC). Chairman Nelson asked for a motion to approve the agenda and the minutes from the September 30, 2019 meeting. Jamie Ison made the motion to approve the agenda and the minutes, and Sydney Raine seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous to approve.

#### **Discussion of Questions**

Henry Nelson stated that an email had been sent on October 29, 2019, by a Commissioner who had a series of questions related to Woodland Prep. Since no one had responded to the questions, he stated that he felt it was appropriate for any of the questions to be addressed openly in this meeting.
